## **Cancer Support Services**

The IFCC single purpose is to help cancer patients and their families who are residents of Ibiza and Formentera islands.

**These services include:**

- **Providing Economic Support to needy Cancer Patients and their Families**
- **Finance specific treatments for patients not provided for by the Health Services, provision of wigs, limfodema massages and/or required medication**
- **Promoting the establishment of Radiotherapy Services in Ibiza**
- **Provision of two dedicated vehicle for the Palliative Care Team in order to provide Home Services**
- **Funding Cancer Prevention & Information Campaigns, i.e. Colon Screening Programme, Breast Cancer Awareness etc...**

For many patients and their families the diagnosis of cancer means lengthy periods of treatment, which can include the added stress of travelling to Mallorca for treatment, especially radiotherapy.

IFCC supports efforts to advance services in Ibiza so that patients and their families do not have the added burden of travelling away from home for treatment.

In the meantime, IFCC working with the relevant authorities and agencies has put in-place a number of services to assist people who have to travel to Palma for treatment.

**These include:**

- **Services of a dedicated English/Spanish translator in Mallorca who is also linked with the nursing staff specifically to support Ibiza y Formentera Residents in the Cancer Centre in Son Espases Hospital.**
- **Information on transport service options to and from the Palma airport to Son Espases Hospital.**
- **Information pertaining to accommodation options for patients and a companion during their stay in Palma.**
- **Information on the dedicated 'Waiting Lounge for Cancer Patients' available at Palma Airport.**
